## Project Summary

REILLY was contracted by the US Army Corps of Engineers to renovate and/ or re-commission approximately twenty three separate buildings (115 individual living units) in an effort to provide temporary housing for the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for families and individuals displaced after the Oct. 29th super storm that devastated the Jersey shore.

## Achievements

- Delivered project in less than seven weeks
- Zero lost time accidents
- Zero unsafe incidents
- Installed 78 kitchens (approx. 550 cabinets)
- Installed approx. 445 new appliances
- Installed approx. 450 new plumbing fixtures (ranging from sinks to hot water heaters)
- Painted nearly 800,000 Sq. Ft. of walls & ceilings
- Installed nearly 60,000 Sq. Ft. of carpet & tile
- Installed nearly 2,500 Ln. Ft. of chain link fencing
- Landscaped (general housekeeping) nearly 12 acres
- Paving and line stipe of various parking lots, common areas & roads



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**Challenges**

Due to the high profile and extremely time sensitive nature of this project, REILLY and its subcontractor forces worked around the clock (avg. 2-3 shifts per day) to ensure on time delivery.

- Procuring and receiving long lead items; i.e. cabinets, appliances, broadloom carpet, etc.
- Coordinating sub trades and in house forces (14-16 REILLY carpenters daily) working together simultaneously in multiple buildings, on various floors in tight quarters
- Maintaining high standard of safety and quality control on various sites being worked simultaneously
- Coordinating various aspects of construction, submittals, scheduling, delivery & turn over methods with the USACE & FEMA in effort to maintain the extremely aggressive schedule
- Coordinating and facilitating various federal and state media events and VIP visitors

**Services**

REILLY completed approx. 60% of this project with its own in house forces. We self-performed all carpentry related work (rough & finish framing), drywall & finishing, general labor, landscaping, selective demolition and misc. finish work.
