Project Summary

This new Aquatic Conversation and Education Center is home to one of the most energy efficient buildings ever built by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The center features energy0efficient mechanical and electrical systems, recycled and locally available building materials, educational exhibits and meeting space, storm water capture and re-use and native plantings. This building has achieved Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Silver certification.

LEED is an internationally recognized green building certification system. In addition to its sustainable design features, the center includes an environmental education classroom, retail space, additional office space, fish habitat displays and interpretive exhibits, and outdoor features such as a display pond and viewing areas.

This building is the brick-and-mortar embodiment of FWS's conservation mission.
